Do remember to complete the given tasks after reading them carefully.

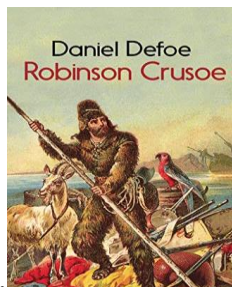

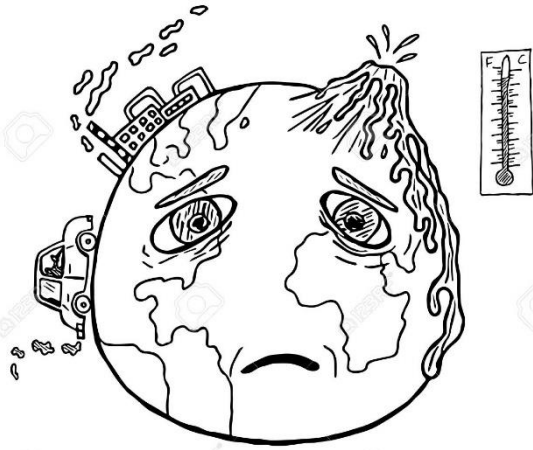
